Server Hardware	Computer/Processor	1 GHz or higher Pentium-compatible central processing unit (CPU).
	Memory	1 Gigabytes (GB) of RAM recommended minimum (4 gigabytes maximum).
	Hard Disk	At least 1.0 GB free space on hard-disk. Actual requirement is dependant on database size.
	Drive	CD-ROM or DVD optical drive.
	Display	VGA (640 x 480 pixels) or higher-resolution monitor
	Peripheral	Keyboard and Microsoft Mouse or compatible pointing device (optional). Ensure that all system components are on the Hardware Compatibility List (HCL) for Windows Server 2003.
Server Software	Operating System	Microsoft® Windows® Server NT/2000/2003/2008 or Sun Solaris.
	Database Server	Microsoft SQL Server, Oracle 8i (or higher). <i>For SQL Server, a CAL is required for each 'concurrent' user (not total number of users)</i>
Client Hardware	Computer/Processor	1 GHz or higher Pentium-compatible central processing unit (CPU).
	Memory	1 Gigabytes (GB) of RAM recommended minimum (4 gigabytes maximum).
	Hard Disk	At least 1 Gigabytes (GB) free space on hard-disk.
	Drive	CD-ROM or DVD optical drive.
	Display	VGA (640 x 480 pixels) or higher-resolution monitor.
	Peripheral	Keyboard and mouse or compatible pointing device.
Client Software		Operating System Microsoft® Windows® NT/2000/XP/VISTA/7.
Portal Software	Operating System	Microsoft .NET Framework 1.1.4322 or later.
		Microsoft Internet Information Server* (IIS) 5.1 or later. Compatible with Windows NT 4.0 Server, Windows 2000 Server, and Windows 2003 Server. IIS is the default web server for Windows Servers. Note: Windows NT 4.0 servers need Option Pack 1 installed and may need to be updated to version 5.0 (or later) of the Microsoft Scripting Engine, which is available for free from Microsoft at http://www.microsoft.com/scripting/

**CATS can be run on the version of IIS included with Windows 2000 Professional and Windows XP Professional. However, the version of IIS supplied in the non-server operating systems has different limitations than the full server OS, which only makes it suitable for site testing and development machines running Windows 2000 or XP Professional.*
